Prior experience with demand forecasting, capacity expansion planning, or similar quantitative market work is helpful, as is comfort working with large datasets including time series. Experience preparing slide decks and written outputs for clients is also valued. This profile therefore suits someone who can move between technical tasks and careful written output, and who is willing to deepen capability in these methods over time.
